First Year – Brookhaven, Eastfield, El Centro, Mountain View, North Lake, and Richland College²

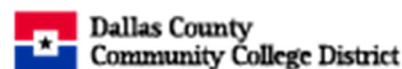
Fourth Year Courses – Texas Wesleyan University
