The investigator gave me their business card, which includes their email address. I understand the DOS investigator will email me updates regarding the status of the investigation. I want the investigator to email me at I understand I am responsible for reading and responding to emails in a timely manner. I will have the opportunity to review and provide a written response to the information the investigator collects before they make a decision about whether the Respondent violated UNT policy. The investigator will email me when I can review the record, and I will have up to three business days from when I receive that email to review and respond. I received a no contact order. The investigator verbally identified, by first and last name, the person I am not permitted to communicate with. I understand this person is also not permitted to communicate with me. I can contact the investigator by phone or email to report any violation of the no contact order. The investigator explained what retaliation means and how UNT prohibits retaliation. I can contact the investigator by phone or email to report any suspected retaliation. The investigator explained my right to be accompanied to any meeting associated with the investigation by an advisor of my choice. I understand that an advisor cannot speak for me. I understand that if I want to be accompanied by an attorney I must inform the investigator in advance. I understand UNT will investigate my complaint to determine if the respondent violated UNT policy. UNT does not determine if a violation of the law occurred. I can always to make a report to the police. The investigator discussed the role of the Survivor Advocate in assisting complainants.
