

- You must take CDEC 2286, CDEC 2287, and CDEC 2380 at the college where you plan to graduate and earn the AAS
- @ You must take CDEC 1413 at the college where you plan to earn the Certificate.

 + These courses are count toward the Child Development Elective course within the Child Development/Early Childhood Education Certificate (CD1).
