SEMESTER-BY-SEMESTER MAP FOR FULL-TIME STUDENTS
This is an example course sequence for students interested in pursuing the Associate of Arts pathway in Drama designed to meet the needs of students who plan to major in Drama (or Theatre) and transfer to a four-year college/university for a major or minor in Technical Theater, Stage Management, or Design. Although there may be several options to fulfill certain requirements for the associate's degree, please note that this pathway lists the specific courses leading to this bachelor's degree. All plans can be modified to fit the needs of part-time students. This is not an official degree plan. Refer to catalog for official degree requirements. You must receive a GPA of at least 2.00 on all college-level course work. Students must earn at least 25% of the credit hours required for graduation through instruction by Dallas College.
