**ECON 2301** – Principles of Macroeconomics  
**CHOOSE ONE:** MATH 1324 – Mathematics for Business & Social Sciences This is a (CB 020) Core course. Must earn a grade of "C" or higher. **OR**  
 BUSI 2305 – Business Statistics  
**CHOOSE ONE:** SPCH 1311 – Introduction to Speech Communication **OR**  
 SPCH 1321 – Business and Professional Communication **OR**  
 SPCH 1315 – Public Speaking These are (CB 090) Core courses.

\* To register for BUSI 2305 you must have completed the following prerequisite courses: MATH 1324 or MATH 1314 AND BCIS 1305 or BCIS 1405.

**MATH/SCIENCE ELECTIVE** – See catalog for college-level Math or Science course. Consult with your academic advisor to choose an appropriate elective based on the university to which you plan to transfer.

**CHOOSE ONE:** HIST 1302 – United States History II **OR**
