DCCCD DATA SHARING

DCCCD has data sharing agreements with 10 ISDs
15,000+ dual credit students
19% of DCCCD enrollment

DCCCD DATA SHARING AGREEMENTS (5 years)

DATA SHARING FORMATS

- **SQL Database with VPN (Virtual Private Network) access**
- **Data sent encrypted to SFTP (Secure File Transfer Process)**

- **To the ISDs?**
- **To the high schools?**

When do they want it?

How are you providing it?

DISD

Data fields are available in SQL data base they have access to view.

Other than DISD

- We pull a list of students noted in ERP from high schools within the ISD. Send each term – mid term.
- ISD must verify these are their students to meet FERPA.
- DCCCD Information shared after grades posted:
 - Current Course Enrollment status, final grade, GPA, TSI status/exemption, academic standing and if requested TSI test scores.

ISSUES WITH DATA GATHERING

- Names students use to apply vs ISD official student record
- Identifying students by high schools
- ISD's IT not sharing data with schools
- Not all of the ISDs are tech ready & still want paper
- Securely sending data
