SEMESTER 1

ENGL 1301 – Composition I This is a (CB 010) Core course. Must receive a grade of 'C' or higher.
HIST 1301 – United States History I This is a (CB 060) Core course.
MATH 1342 – Elementary Algebra This is a (CB 020) Core course. Must earn a grade of 'C' or higher.

CHOOSE ONE: **SPCH 1311** – Introduction to Speech Communication OR
