Credit for Prior Learning

Credit for prior learning is granted for successful completion of the TXDOT training listed in the left column below. College credit granted through credit for prior learning is posted to the transcript after the student has enrolled at the college and the following criteria must be met to earn credit through prior learning experiences: •The student must be enrolled in a COM certificate or degree program in the current semester. •The student must provide official documentation (transcripts, license/certification, etc.) supporting the request for credit. •The student must meet eligibility requirements specific to the PLA option. •The student must satisfactorily complete six (6) non-developmental credit hours at COM prior to application for PLA. •The PLA credit must apply to the student's certificate or degree at COM. •No more than 24 credit hours may be earned through PLA applicable to a degree at COM; however, no more than 50% of a workforce certificate may be earned through PLA options.
